

## FAQ: Are You a Victim of Unemployment Fraud?

### I received a 1099G form from the Kansas Department of Labor (KDOL). Why did I receive this form?

- Kansas uses the 1099G form to report unemployment compensation paid by the state in your name or over-paid taxes refunded from the previous tax year. 1099G forms must be mailed by January 31 each year.
- If you received unemployment compensation from KDOL in 2020, you are receiving the 1099G form to include with your annual tax return for 2020. Box 1 shows the total compensation paid by KDOL in 2020.

### I received a 1099G form for unemployment compensation paid in my name, but the claim was fraudulent. How to I notify KDOL?

If you have not yet notified KDOL the claim is fraudulent, first visit <https://www.dol.ks.gov/fraud> for more information on what to do when your identity has been stolen. You can report the fraudulent unemployment claim to the state of Kansas by calling KDOL's Fraud Hotline at 785-291-6059.

### What if I cannot get through to someone on the Fraud Hotline?

Report the fraudulent activity online at <https://www.dol.ks.gov/fraud>. Click on the blue button that reads "Click Here to Report Fraudulent Activity."

### What happens after I report the activity to the KDOL?

If you have already notified KDOL about the fraudulent activity, you should have received an email with a Police Report number. Obtain the Police Report number before you complete and submit your Unsworn Declaration on the KDOL Self-Service portal at <https://www.dol.ks.gov/ui-faqs/1099g-forms>. (If you have not yet notified KDOL the claim is fraudulent, see above.)

- Click on the second to last bullet: "How do I report fraud if I received a 1099G form for a fraudulent claim In My Name?"
- Click on "KDOL Self-Service Portal" (you do not need to create a log in to file the Unsworn Declaration form).
- You will be directed to an online form entitled "Unemployment Assistance Request," where you will

see drop-down boxes for "I am an" and "I need to." Click on the appropriate options; then click on "Next."

- Follow the wizard within the portal to file the protest. Currently this site does not provide any confirmation that your protest was received.

Be sure to include your full name and last 4 digits of your social security number, along with the reason for identity theft and a copy of a completed Unsworn Declaration form (get one here: <https://www.dol.ks.gov/docs/default-source/ui-benefits-forms/1099-g-forms/k-frd-100.pdf>)

### How was my information made available? Has Inspire been hacked or data been breached?

Inspire has not been hacked, and data in Inspire has not been breached. OMNI does not have access to your password or Virtual Code Settings that you created. Your log-in information is confidential only to you.

### How does OMNI communicate sensitive information?

When OMNI sends personal or sensitive information, such as social security number, date of birth, and/or signature via email, our practice is as follows:

- We password-protect all documents before sending and send a separate email with the password.
- If a document cannot be password protected, we send the document via encrypted email. The recipient of the encrypted email must create a log-in account. Upon creating the account, the recipient will be able to access documents from OMNI and send sensitive documents to OMNI.
